Eric Dade raced to a new freshman school record in the 2 mile with a time of 10:03.4.

Scott Filip completed a "triple crown" winning the 110 HH, high jump and long jump. His leap of 21' 4" broke the long jump meet record.

Craig Ryan and Per Johnson teamed up for a 1-2 finish in the discus.

The 4 x 800 relay team of Ryan Horgan, Joe Ley, Mike Strachan and Andy Birkley finished in 8:51.2 good for 3rd place. Tim Ehrhardt took 1st place in the vault with 12' 6".

Marcus Jegede added a 2nd place finish in the long jump. Mike Amerlan jumped to 2nd place in the triple jump. Jakub Jezusek and Mason Wieclawek set Pr's in the 400m with times of 57.73 and 57.11. Jeremy Lozano set a new PR in the 2 mile with a time of 10:15.3
