The Frosh/Soph Lancers competed at the Hersey Invite last night. The meet is extremely competitive and one glance at the meet records is a sneak peak at future All State athletes. To win here means your future is bright. And last night the Lancers captured 1st place by a mere half of a point! The scoring began with Chago Basso and Jarod Pankau finishing 1st and 5th in the Discus. The 4x100 relay of Solomon Sangobowale, Tyler Davis, Darius Allen and Jarkeyse Brackett passed the baton for 4th place. The 4x200 relay of Sangobowale, Davis, Alec Verven, and Brackett also took 4th. Dan Spejcher capped another great night with 1st place finishes in the Long Jump, 110HH and 2nd in the High Jump. In a race that was a close as the team battle, Alex Caines leaned at the line for 1st place in the 800. Teammate Jason Joda kicked for 3rd in the same event. Back in the Shot Put ring, Basso and Jacub Panasiuk captured 1st and 3rd respectively. In the 3200, Robert Kincanon and Billy Murphy both set new PRs as did Luke Worwa in the 400 and Alex Jorgensen in the 1600. Jacub Hianik set a new PR in the 300 Hurdles while taking 6th. And in the final event of the night, Ethan Koval brought home gold with a 1st in the Pole Vault. Nobody knew it at that time, but the Lancers were down by 9.5 points with just that event remaining. The 10 points that go along with 1st were enough to put the Lancers over the top!
