## Lancers Take 2nd at DVC...

This past Friday night the Lancers competed in the DVC Conference meet. The Varsity team captured 2nd place while the Frosh/Soph team was 6th.

Varsity Shot Put could not have gone any better as Dylan Scheirich, Mike Prestigiacomio and Chago Basso swept the top 3 places. Discus was almost as good with Prestigiacomio, Basso and Austin Lynch taking 1st, 2nd and 4th. Vaulters Ethan Koval and Kyle Brown both set new PRs as they took 1st and 3rd. Gio Basso won the Long Jump with a new PR. Antonio Shenault defended his title in the 110HH and also took 2nd in the 100m. The 4x800 relay of Jason Joda, Alex Caines, Will Dover and Zach Schwarz captured 2nd. The 4x100 relay of Gio Basso, Greg Love, Tommie Jackson and Shenault also got up for 2nd place. PR performances included Colin Kirkham in the 3200, Solomon Sangobowale in the Long Jump, and Dan Spejcher in the 110HH and Triple Jump. Strong performances for the Lancers but the overall team depth of Wheaton North proved to be too much to overcome.

At the Frosh/Soph level Jacob Panasiuk won the Shot Put, while fellow thrower Jarod Pankau won the Discus with a new PR. Tom Paprocki took 2nd in the Pole Vault. Darius Allen took 3rd in the 110HH with a new PR. The 4x200 relay of Jake Hianik, Luke Worwa, David Zelazo and Jarkeyse Brackett took 3rd. Other PRs included Billy Murphy and Robert Kincanon in the 1600m, Vince Shaw and Diamante Smith in the Triple Jump, and Steve and Andrew Beugnet in the 3200m.

Up next for the Lancers is the IHSA Sectional meet this Friday night at York High School. This is the state qualifying meet. Any competitor who finishes 1st or 2nd or hits the qualifying mark qualifies for the state meet. The Lancers will look to defend the Sectional title and set themselves up for another run at a Trophy! Field events start at 4:30 and running finals at 6:30.
